ChristLight: *Peter's Sin and Jesus' Trial before Pilate*

Memory Treasures: Matthew 26:41 *Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the body is weak.* John 8:47a: *He who belongs to God hears what God says.* The Eighth Commandment: *You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor. What does this mean?
